How can we enhance our teaching of phonics and reading skills to improve all pupils' reading accuracy and comprehension skills?



- ☐ We are encouraging regular reading at home and will share resources to help families support their children's reading.
- ☐ Pupils can use **Bug Club** to access eBooks and phonics games online.
- ☐ We are using consistent phonics resources across the school to support early reading.
- ☐ From **Hwb Dysgu 3 to 6**, we are focusing on developing higher-level reading skills through weekly guided reading sessions.

in the community

How does giving pupils real opportunities to use Welsh in the community help them become more confident and independent speakers?



- ☐ Pupils will learn Welsh language patterns and practise them through role play activities in class.
- ☐ Each term, pupils will focus on Welsh language patterns linked to a particular area of the community, such as a café or shop.
- ☐ Classes will visit these places in our community to use the Welsh they have learnt in real situations.
- ☐ Families will be encouraged to use these Welsh phrases and patterns together when out and about in the community.
